On June 30, 2004, President Bush signed Public Law 108-265, the Child Nutrition and WIC Reauthorization Act of 2004. Each local educational agency participating in a program authorized by the Richard B. Russell National School Lunch Act (42 U.S.C. 1751 et seq) or the Child Nutrition Act of 1966 (42 U.S.C. 1771 et seq) shall have established a local school wellness policy by the beginning of the 2006-2007 school year. The Child Nutrition and WIC Reauthorization Act requires that local wellness policies be designed and implemented at the local level. The development of local wellness policies must include local parents, teachers, administrators, school food service, school boards, and the public. The Child Nutrition and WIC Reauthorization Act states that wellness policies must include goals for nutrition education, physical activity, and other school based activities that are designed to promote student wellness.
